Unison Discipline of Confession

Lord Jesus, you lived in the strength of God's love, the knowledge of God's word, and connection to God in prayer, and stood firm through trials and triumphs. We confess that we sometimes spiritualize needs instead of feeding hungry people, and that we sometimes forget there's more to justice than a single meal.
