Unison Discipline of Confession

You are a God of close relationship, a God who sits down beside us, gets your hands dirty, stays in it with us. We confess that we are tempted to treat you with kid gloves, to be careful what we say, holding back some of the whole truth, just in case. Yet you reach out and draw us in to full, real, presence. You put your whole heart in and ask us to do the same. Forgive us when we hold back because we don't want to be changed. Forgive us when we turn away because you don't fit our neat categories. Forgive us when we aren't willing to invest in our relationship with you.
