Unison Discipline of Confession

We love the word hope, but we confess that we are easily seduced by the shallow, naive hope that ignores the trauma of the world, which offers platitudes, wishing for them to be good enough. Or which holds off, not allowing any hope until the pain is already over. But your hope, O God, is rooted in reality. Forgive us for the times we've dismissed hope as naive, assuming it can't help us now. Forgive us for insisting on choosing either suffering or hope, rather than holding both as true. Make space in us for your new world to become a possibility, that we may trust you in the hardest of days and look for your promise to break through.
